After that, Judy saw a salesperson with some food at the Ocean Theatre. She laughed and talked to Judy. They watched sea animals together. Judy felt excited.

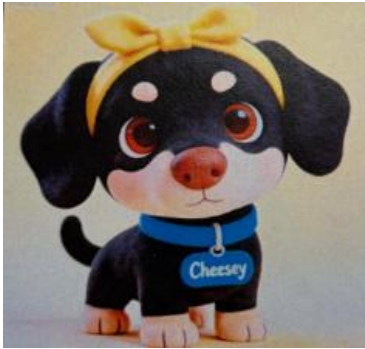


Finally, Judy took the Fun Bus and went home. She felt sleepy but happy. She had a good day.

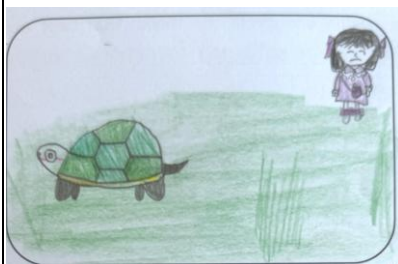
