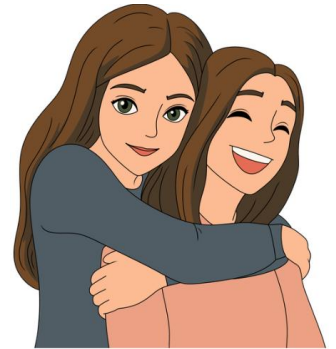


Thank You Letter Tan So Ying Suki 6B (17)
